Tough-PAC® Case Study Walwayne Court School Trowbridge, Wiltshire, England

The Requirement

Walwayne Court School began a project to use iPad in education in 2012. The aim was to use software tools and this new technology to support learning for Key Stage 2 children, some of whom require intervention with their learning. We had already obtained a number of iPads but were concerned about the risk of damage in particular as well as usability and security.

The Solution

During our search for a suitable case to protect iPad we found Tough-PAC®. We contacted Innervision Technology Ltd, the manufacturer who kindly provided us with a trial unit for evaluation. We thought it was exactly what we required but Tough-PAC® does not normally have an external earphone socket, because it is designed for hospital use – this was something that we needed for some applications. So Innervision worked on a solution for us.

Implementation

Tough-PAC® was delivered and installed during the summer break, July 2012. We began using the iPads in the autumn term. Innervision had worked to build in bespoke connections so that we may use earphones but still retain the protection and security that Tough-PAC® provides.

User Feedback

The Tough-PAC® units with iPad have been received extremely well by staff and children alike. The case design means both the children and staff are confident using it in or out of the classroom such that we are expanding the project further this year. We have identified an additional requirement for recording sound and again Innervision is working on a solution for that which can upgrade the existing units and be incorporated into others in the future.
